### **Regional Innovation Pilot Program – Public/Private Partnership Matching Grant**

**Fiscal Year:** FY26

**Administering Agency:** New Jersey Office of the Food Security Advocate (OFSA)

#### **1. Organizational Overview & Eligibility**

- Describe your organization's mission, core activities, and primary service geography in New Jersey.
- Describe your organization's collaboration with partner organizations and your ability to bring stakeholders together.
- Describe your organization's experience working within New Jersey's food system, including partnerships with agricultural producers, food assistance organizations, or community-based entities.
- Identify the primary populations or communities your organization serves.

#### **2. Proposed Project Description**

- Describe the proposed project or model, including its goals, key activities, and intended outcomes.
- Explain how the project will directly strengthen the connection between New Jersey-produced food and residents experiencing food insecurity.

#### **3. Alignment with FY26 Mandate & Strategic Plan**

- Describe how the proposed project advances the FY26 budget language to streamline the provision of food supplied by New Jersey-based agricultural producers to residents in need.
- Identify how the project aligns with Focus Area 2: Expand Community-Based Food Infrastructure and Local Market Channel Creation and specify which strategy or strategies it advances.

#### **4. Implementation Plan & Timeline**

#### **5. Outcomes, Data, and Learning**

- Describe data collection methods and reporting capacity.
- Explain how learning from the pilot could inform future scale-up or replication.

#### **6. Budget, Fiscal Capacity**

- Describe internal fiscal controls, grant management capacity, and experience managing public funds.
- Confirm ability to comply with state reporting, reimbursement, and audit requirements.
- Describe your approach to fiscal reporting, performance monitoring, and compliance with state requirements.
- Provide a quarterly report of how funds were utilized and to whom funds were awarded.

#### **7. Fund Management & Philanthropic Match**

- Describe your organization's experience managing multi-source funds, including public and philanthropic dollars.
- Describe your plan to secure, manage, and document a philanthropic match that meets or exceeds the \$1M state investment.
- Explain how the dedicated fund will be structured, governed, and monitored.

#### **9. Partnership & Convening Role**

- Describe your organization's experience building and managing cross-sector partnerships.



- Explain how you will engage food producers, food assistance organizations, philanthropy, and public agencies as part of the pilot.
- Describe how decision-making, transparency, and accountability will be maintained.
