## RESOLUTION

## **Regarding County DMHAS Youth Leadership Alliance Plans for Grant Term Two**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) was awarded funding to supplement its Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SAPT-BG) from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA); and

**WHEREAS**, the DMHAS and GCADA seek to implement a statewide youth leadership program that will include substance use prevention outreach, education and training services for youth that will utilize supplemental SAPT-BG funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the GCADA warrants and represents that the County Alliance Coordinators and their Municipal Alliances shall be required to coordinate the substance abuse prevention services with GCADA to maximize the utilization of the SAPT-BG services funded under the Memorandum Of Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the GCADA in accordance with the Memorandum Of Agreement with DMHAS, it has received the County DMHAS Youth Leadership Alliance Plans for Grant Term Two from:
