## RESOLUTION

### Regarding County Alliance Plans for Fiscal Year 2026

**WHEREAS**, the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD), the Alliance to Prevent Substance Use Disorder Program were established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:2C:35-15; and,

**WHEREAS**, the GCSUD has the statutory authority to adopt regulatory rules and policies for the administration and governance of the Alliance to Prevent Substance Use Disorder Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the GCSUD also has the statutory authority to adopt a funding formula in order to disperse funds to said Program from the GCSUD Grant fund; and,

**WHEREAS**, the GCSUD in accordance with the GCSUD's adopted rules, it has received the County Alliance Plans for Fiscal Year 2026 from:

**WHEREAS**, the Strategic Plan Review Committee and staff have reviewed the aforementioned County applications and recommend their consideration by the full Council.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the GCSUD approves the following Fiscal Year 2026 County Alliance Grant Awards subject to executing a Letter of Agreement, Grant Agreement and Attachments A and C that shall detail County compliance with reporting, monitoring, evaluation and auditing procedures to ensure that only allowable expenditures are funded and which may be amended during the term of the Award:
