Regarding County Alliance Plan Updates for 2013

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA), the Alliance to Prevent Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Program and the Drug Enforcement Demand Reduction Fund (DEDR) were established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:2BB-1 and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-15; and,

WHEREAS, the GCADA has the statutory authority to adopt regulatory rules and policies for the administration and governance of the Alliance to Prevent Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Program; and,

WHEREAS, the GCADA also has the statutory authority to adopt a funding formula in order to disperse funds to said Program from the DEDR; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the GCADA's adopted rules, it has received the County Alliance Plan Update for 2013 from:

WHEREAS, the GCADA RFP review committee and staff have reviewed the aforementioned County applications and recommend their consideration by the full Council.
