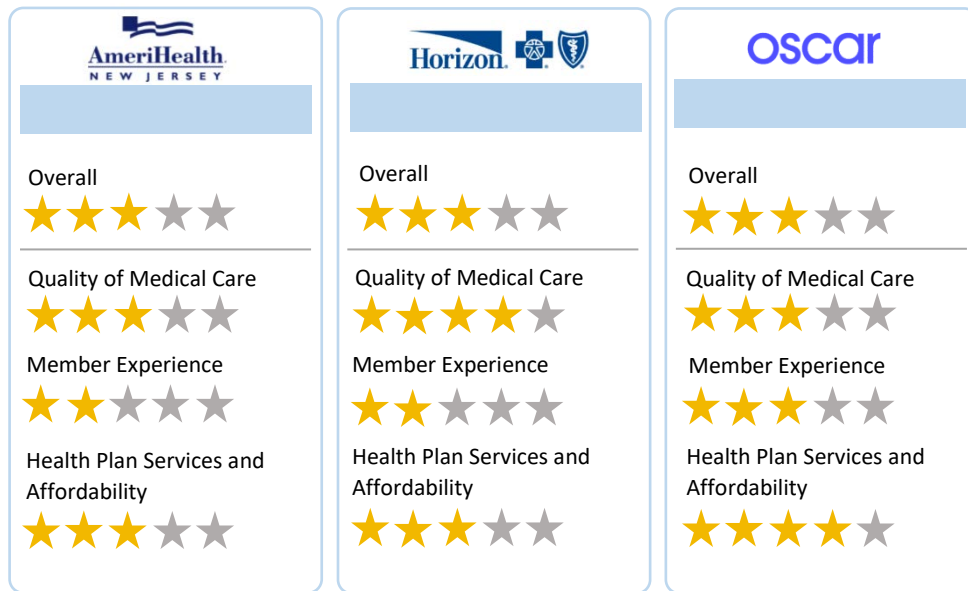


Health Plan Quality Ratings

Get Covered New Jersey provides the following information on the quality ratings of health plans offered through the Marketplace to New Jerseyans. The ratings were compiled from U.S. Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services data and are required by federal regulation to be displayed.

Rating System

Each rated health plan has an “Overall” quality rating of 1 to 5 stars (5 is highest), which accounts for quality of medical care, member experience, and health plan services and affordability. Quality rating information for carriers operating on the State-Based Exchange, Get Covered New Jersey, is below. Note: Rating information has not become available for WellCare of New Jersey, operating for the first year on the exchange in 2022, or Aetna CVS Health, who will be new to the exchange in 2023.
