4 things to know about enrolling in health insurance outside of Open Enrollment

- You may qualify to save money most people do! In fact, 9 out of 10 people who enroll are eligible for financial help, and many people receiving assistance can find a plan for \$10 a month or less after savings.
- New Jersey residents who had a major life event can still access quality, affordable health insurance. The annual Open Enrollment Period (November 1-January 31 each year) is typically the only time that consumers can enroll in coverage for the following year. Outside of that, consumers can qualify for a Special Enrollment Period (SEP) by reporting a qualifying life event, such as becoming pregnant, losing job-based coverage, or moving, which will allow them to enroll in a plan through Get Covered New Jersey. They may also qualify to enroll through an SEP based on income.
- An Expanded Access Special Enrollment Period is available! Eligible consumers who have a yearly income up to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (\$30,120 for an individual or \$62,400 for a family of four in 2025) can now qualify for the Expanded Access Special Enrollment Period and can access free or nearly free health plans throughout the year.
- Help getting coverage is available. You can get help filling out your application by phone, with a trained assister, agent, or broker. Find local help at GetCovered.NJ.gov.
