Things to know about enrolling in health insurance outside of Open Enrollment

- You may qualify to save money — most people do! In fact, eight out of 10 people who enroll are eligible for financial help.
- New Jersey residents who had a major life event can still access quality plans that cover comprehensive health care services. The annual Open Enrollment Period, which begins November 1, is typically the only time that consumers can enroll in coverage for the following year. Outside of that, consumers can qualify for a Special Enrollment Period by reporting a qualifying life event, such as becoming pregnant, losing job-based coverage, or moving, which will allow them to enroll in a plan through Get Covered New Jersey.
- Help getting coverage is available. You can get help filling out your application by phone, with a trained agent or broker. Find local help at [GetCovered.NJ.gov](https://www.getcovered.nj.gov).
