**Case Disposition:** The Complainant asserts a denial of access to her Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") request for 2006 Housing Authority Budget. The Complainant argues that she was not provided with approved documents because the records responsive lack the appropriate signatures. The Custodian certifies that he provided the Complainant with all requested documents.

Type of Administrative Disposition: Requested records provided to Complainant.

**Applicable OPRA Provisions:** "...government records shall be readily accessible for inspection, copying, or examination by the citizens of this State, with certain exceptions..." <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-1.

*"Government record"* or *"record"* means any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device, or any copy thereof, that has been made, maintained or kept on file ... or that has been received in the course of his or its official business ... <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-1.1.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
