Case Disposition: The Complainant asserts a denial of access to records requested on April 14, 2007; however the GRC does not have jurisdiction over records request made of the Superior Court- Hudson Vicinage, as it falls under the Judicial branch of government.

Type of Administrative Disposition: Judicial or legislative jurisdiction not within the scope of OPRA.

Applicable OPRA Provision: N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7.g. provides that: “[t]he council shall not have jurisdiction over the Judicial or Legislative Branches of State Government or any agency, officer, or employee of those branches.”

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
