Case Disposition: The Custodian certifies that the Essex County Prosecutor's Office does not maintain a record that is responsive to the Complainant's OPRA request. The GRC notes that the Custodian responded within the statutorily mandated seven (7) business days on September 26, 2007.

Type of Administrative Disposition: No Records Responsive to Request

Applicable OPRA Provision: N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 defines a government record as "... any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device, or any copy thereof, that has been *made, maintained or kept on file...* or that has been *received...*" (Emphasis added.)

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
