Complaint Disposition: The Complainant asserts a denial of access to records requested on January 18, 2017. However, the GRC does not have jurisdiction over records requests made to the Superior Court – Ocean Vicinage, as it falls under the Judicial Branch of government.

Applicable OPRA Provision: The council shall not have jurisdiction over the Judicial or Legislative Branches of State Government or any agency, officer, or employee of those branches.” N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7(g).

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
