Administrative Complaint Disposition – Unripe Cause of Action

Jeffrey Voigt Complainant GRC Complaint No. 2021-138

v.

Village of Ridgewood (Bergen) Custodial Agency

Custodian of Record: Donna Jackson

Request Received by Custodian: June 21, 2021 GRC Complaint Received: June 30, 2021

Complaint Disposition: The Complainant provided his OPRA request for e-mails to the Custodian on June 21, 2021. The Complainant verified his complaint on June 30, 2021 at 11:22 a.m., which is seventh (7th) business days from the date the Custodian received the Complainant's OPRA requests. OPRA provides that the Custodian "... shall grant access to a government record or deny access to a government record as soon as possible, but not later than seven business days after receiving the request ..." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(i). Here, this complaint is materially defective and shall be dismissed because the requested e-mails are not immediate access records and because the Complainant verified his complaint before the statutory time period provided for the Custodian to respond had expired.²

Applicable OPRA Provision: "... [A] custodian of a government record shall grant access to a government record or deny access to a government record as soon as possible, but not later than seven business days after receiving the request ..." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(i).

"A person who is denied access to a government record by the custodian of the record . . . may institute a proceeding to challenge the custodian's decision by filing . . . a complaint with the Government Records Council . . ." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
