

## NEW JERSEY GOVERNMENT RECORDS COUNCIL Administrative Complaint Disposition – No Records Responsive to the Request Exist

**Custodian of Record:** Stephen Pogany **Request Received by Custodian:** March 10, 2022 **GRC Complaint Received:** May 31, 2022

**Complaint Disposition:** The Custodian certified that he responded to the Complainant in writing within the statutorily mandated response time indicating that no records responsive to the OPRA request exist.<sup>1</sup> Additionally, the Complainant failed to provide any evidence to contradict the Custodian's certification. Thus, this complaint shall be dismissed because the evidence of record reflects that no responsive records exist.

**Applicable OPRA Provision:** "Government record' or 'record' means any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device, or any copy thereof, that has been made, maintained or kept on file in the course of his or its official business . . ." <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-1.1.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days. The Complainant's own OPRA request stating that Mr. Davis was "held in custody for approximately one week" and subsequently "released" in April 1982 appears to support the absence of him from the system.
