## Administrative Order – In Camera Review

v.

Ramapo College of New Jersey Custodial Agency

**Request Received by Custodian:** June 2, 2022 **GRC Complaint Received:** June 20, 2022

Order: The GRC must conduct an *in camera* review of the responsive redacted incident reports to determine the validity of the Custodian's assertion that those records were lawfully redacted under the cited exemptions. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1; N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9(a). See Paff v. N.J. Dep't of Labor, Bd. of Review, 379 N.J. Super. 346, 355 (App. Div. 2005). Thus, the Custodian shall deliver to the Council in a sealed envelope nine (9) copies of the requested unredacted e-mails, nine (9) copies of the redacted e-mails, a document or redaction index.<sup>2</sup>

This is an Administrative Order requiring compliance within ten (10) business days after receipt thereof. The Custodian shall also simultaneously deliver<sup>3</sup> certified confirmation of compliance with this Order, in accordance with <u>N.J. Court Rules</u>, <u>R.</u> 1:4-4,<sup>4</sup> to the Executive Director.
