Administrative Order – In Camera Review

v.

Custodian of Record: Lt. Edward Augustyn Request Received by Custodian: March 3, 2020 GRC Complaint Received: March 4, 2022

Order: The GRC must conduct an *in camera* review of all responsive e-mail correspondence to determine the validity of the Custodian's assertion that those records were exempt under the criminal investigatory records exemption, and the deliberative process privilege. See Paff v. N.J. Dep't of Labor, Bd. of Review, 379 N.J. Super. 346, 355 (App. Div. 2005). Thus, the Custodian shall deliver to the Council in a sealed envelope nine (9) copies of the requested unredacted record(s), nine (9) copies of the redacted records, and a document or redaction index.

This is an Administrative Order requiring compliance within ten (10) business days after receipt thereof. The Custodian shall also simultaneously deliver certified confirmation of compliance with this Order, in accordance with N.J. Court Rules, R. 1:4-4, to the Executive Director that the records provided are the records requested by the Council for the *in camera* inspection.
