Complaint Disposition: The Custodian certified that she performed a search of the electronic local property database using the name “Samuel Jay Krasner” and no responsive records were found. The Custodian certified that she responded to the Complainant in writing within the statutorily mandated response time informing him that she was unable to fulfill the request and asked him to provide more specific information; however, the Complainant did not reply. Furthermore, the Complainant failed to provide any evidence to contradict the Custodian’s certification. Thus, this complaint shall be dismissed because the evidence of record reflects that no responsive records exist.

Applicable OPRA Provision: “‘Government record’ or ‘record’ means any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device, or any copy thereof, that has been made, maintained or kept on file in the course of his or its official business . . .” N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
