Order: The GRC must conduct an *in camera* review of the Standard Operating Procedure entitled “Foreign License Reciprocity Waivers” to determine the validity of the Custodian’s assertion that those records were exempt under the cited exemptions. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1. See Paff v. N.J. Dep’t of Labor, Bd. of Review, 379 N.J. Super. 346, 355 (App. Div. 2005). **Thus, the Custodian shall deliver¹ to the Council in a sealed envelope nine (9) copies of the requested unredacted record, nine (9) copies of the redacted record, and a document or redaction index.²**

This is an Administrative Order requiring compliance within ten (10) business days after receipt thereof. The Custodian shall also simultaneously deliver certified confirmation of compliance with this Order, in accordance with N.J. Court Rules, R. 1:4-4,³ to the Executive Director that the record provided is the record requested by the Council for the *in camera* inspection.

¹ The *in camera* records may be sent overnight mail, regular mail, or be hand-delivered, at the discretion of the Custodian, as long as the GRC physically receives them by the deadline.

² The document or redaction index should identify the record and/or each redaction asserted and the lawful basis for the denial.

³ “I certify that the foregoing statements made by me are true. I am aware that if any of the foregoing statements made by me are willfully false, I am subject to punishment.”
