**Administrative Complaint Disposition – Anonymous Complaints Not Permitted**

**Complaint Disposition:** The Complainant submitted six (6) OPRA requests between May 28, 2023 and May 31, 2025 using the name “Frank James,” an address for Woodbridge’s Municipal Court, and a telephone number belonging to another complainant.<sup>2</sup> This consolidated complaint followed; however, based upon the evidence of record, the subject OPRA requests were filed by a requestor using a pseudonym.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, the consolidated complaint is impermissible based on OPRA’s clear statutory language prohibiting anonymous requestors,<sup>4</sup> inclusive of those using a pseudonym, from filing a Denial of Access Complaint. Thus, this consolidated complaint shall be dismissed.

**Applicable OPRA Provision:** “A request may be submitted anonymously provided, however, that anonymous requestors shall not be permitted to institute proceedings pursuant to [N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7].” N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(f).

“A person who is denied access to a government record by the custodian of the record, at the option of the requestor who is accurately identified by name, may, within 45 days of the date of denial . . . file a complaint with the Government Records Council established pursuant to [N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7].” N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

**This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days. <sup>4</sup> The GRC stresses that while anonymous requestors are prohibited from filing complaints, OPRA still allows requestors to submit OPRA requests anonymously. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(f). Custodians receiving anonymous requests should address them the same as OPRA requests where the requestor is not anonymous.
