



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
May 27, 2010 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 9:54 a.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Beth Auerswald (designee of Commissioner Bret Schundler, Department of Education) and Charles Richman (designee of Commissioner Lori Grifa, Department of Community Affairs).

Also in attendance were GRC Staff: Executive Director Catherine Starghill, In-House Counsel Karyn Gordon, GRC Staff Secretary Brigitte Hairston, Designated Outside Counsel Gina Orozo and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen.

1. **Steve Hyman v. Jersey City (Hudson) (2007-118) (In-Camera Review)**

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations and agreed that they were all appropriate.

2. **Jesse Wolosky v. Township of Sparta (Sussex) (2008-219) (In-Camera Review)**

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations and agreed that they were appropriate.

3. **Gary DeMarzo v. City of Wildwood (Cape May) (2009-61) (In-Camera Review)**

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendation and agreed that they were appropriate.

A motion was made by Mr. Richman and seconded by Ms. Auerswald to end the closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.
