



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
June 29, 2010 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 9:50 a.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Faith Sarafin and Beth Auerswald (designees of Commissioner Bret Schundler, Department of Education), Stacy Spera (designee of the Department of Community Affairs Commissioner Lori Grifa for the sole purpose of adjudication Neil Yoskin v. NJ Department of Environmental Protection, 2009-117 and Charles Richman (designee of Commissioner Lori Grifa, Department of Community Affairs).

Also in attendance were GRC Staff: Executive Director Catherine Starghill, In-House Counsel Karyn Gordon, GRC Staff Secretary Brigitte Hairston, Designated Outside Counsel Gina Orozo and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen.

A motion was made by Mr. Richman and seconded by Ms. Sarafin to go into closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b(7) to receive legal advice and discuss anticipated litigation in which the public body may become a party in the following matter:

1. John Paff v. City of Gloucester (Camden) (2009-102) (***In-Camera Review***)

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations and agreed that they were appropriate.

2. Neil Yoskin v. NJ Department of Environmental Protection (2009-117) (***In-Camera Review***)

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations and agreed that they were appropriate.

A motion was made by Ms. Spera and seconded by Ms. Sarafin to end the closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.
