



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
July 27, 2010 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 10:28 a.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Anthony Bland (designee of Commissioner Bret Schundler, Department of Education), and Charles Richman (designee of Commissioner Lori Grifa, Department of Community Affairs).

Also in attendance were GRC Staff: Executive Director Catherine Starghill, In-House Counsel Karyn Gordon, GRC Staff Secretary Brigitte Hairston, GRC Staff John Stewart and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen.

A motion was made by Mr. Bland and seconded by Mr. Richman to go into closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b(7) to receive legal advice and discuss anticipated litigation in which the public body may become a party in the following matter:

1. Richard Rivera v. Wall Township Police Department (Monmouth) (2008-281)

The Council was advised that this complaint had previously being combined and adjudicated with Richard Rivera v. Wall Township Police Department (Monmouth), 2008-280. However, the adjudication today is simply procedural to sever the two complaints since 2008-281 was adjudication to completion at the April 27, 2010 Council meeting while the 2008-280 complaint was adjudicated as an Interim Order.

A motion was made by Mr. Richman and seconded by Mr. Bland to end the closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The closed session meeting concluded at 10:31 a.m.
