



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
August 24, 2010 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 9:38 a.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Anthony Bland (designee of Commissioner Bret Schundler, Department of Education), and Stacy Spera (designee of Commissioner Lori Grifa, Department of Community Affairs).

Also in attendance were GRC Staff: Executive Director Catherine Starghill, In-House Counsel Karyn Gordon, GRC Staff Secretary Brigitte Hairston, and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen.

A motion was made by Mr. Bland and seconded by Ms. Spera to go into closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b(7) to receive legal advice and discuss anticipated litigation in which the public body may become a party in the following matter:

1. Jacqueline Andrews v. Township of Irvington (Essex) (2008-232) and (2008-243)

The Council was advised that since the Division of Law had not pursued an enforcement action as ordered by the Council in these matters, the Executive Director is now recommending both complaints be sent to the Office of Administrative Law for fact finding hearings.

2. Jesse Wolosky v. Andover Regional School District (Sussex) (2009-94) In-Camera Review

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations.

3. Miguel Mendes v. Freedom Academy Charter School (Camden) (2009-184) In-Camera Review

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations.

A motion was made by Ms. Spera and seconded by Mr. Bland to end the closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The closed session meeting concluded at 10:07 a.m.
