



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
December 21, 2010 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 1:09 p.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Denise Parkinson Vetti (designee of Department of Education Acting Commissioner Rochelle Hendricks), and James Requa (designee of Department of Community Affairs Commissioner Lori Grifa).

Also in attendance were GRC Staff: Executive Director Catherine Starghill, GRC Secretary Brigitte Hairston, GRC Communications Manager Dara Lownie, and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen.

A motion was made by Ms. Vetti and seconded by Mr. Requa to go into closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b(7) to receive legal advice and discuss anticipated litigation in which the public body may become a party in the following matters:

1. Jesse Wolosky v. Township of Sparta (Sussex) (2009-151) *In-Camera Review*

The Council reviewed the unredacted records and the Executive Director's recommendations based on the *in-camera review*. The Council members discussed the recommendations.

A motion was made by Mr. Requa and seconded by Ms. Vetti to end the closed session. The motion was adopted by a unanimous vote.
