



**Minutes of the Government Records Council  
February 24, 2015 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 1:44 p.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Esq.
