



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
June 30, 2015 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 1:52 p.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Esq. (Chairwoman), Dominic Rota, Esq. (designee of Department of Education Commissioner David C. Hespe), and Dana Lane, Esq. (designee of Department of Community Affairs Commissioner Charles A. Richman).

Mr. Rota made a motion, seconded by Ms. Lane, to go into closed session. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(7) to receive legal advice and discuss anticipated litigation in which the public body may become a party in the following matters:

- Luis Rodriguez v. Kean University (2013-71) - *Tabled pending legal review*
- Robert A. Verry v. Franklin Township Fire District No. 1 (Somerset) (2013-287)
- Harry B. Scheeler, Jr. v. NJ Motor Vehicle Commission (2014-75) - *Tabled pending legal review*

Mr. Caruso introduced GRC Complaint No. 2013-287 to the Council. Ms. Stern provided legal advice, which included a discussion of attorney-client privilege and e-mail content. The Council reviewed the written recommendation and consented to the legal advice as provided.

Mr. Rota made a motion, seconded by Ms. Lane, to end the closed session. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote. The closed session meeting concluded at 2:00 p.m.
