DID YOU KNOW?



Last year's flu season was classified as "moderate severity" and resulted in around 26 million illnesses, 340,000 hospitalizations, and 21,000 deaths.¹

Up to 75% of employees miss work due to the flu for about 2-3 days. People who got the flu vaccine missed less time from work compared to those who did not.²

You can help protect yourself, your family, co-workers, and patients by getting your flu vaccine each season.
