Facilities



## DID YOU KNOW?



Last year's flu season was classified as "high severity" and resulted in around 56 million illnesses, 25 million medical visits, and 770,000 hospitalizations.<sup>1</sup>

Up to 75% of employees miss work due to the flu for about 2-3 days. People who got the flu vaccine missed less time from work compared to those who did not.<sup>2</sup>

You can help protect yourself, your family, co-workers, and patients by getting your flu vaccine each season.
