## An Important Message from Your Dentists

#### Dear Patient,

Understanding how antibiotics work as part of your dental treatment is very important. Here are some things to know:

- Antibiotics will generally NOT help in healing your toothache.
- If you take antibiotics when you don't need them, they may cause:
  - Diarrhea, rashes, or yeast infections
  - Bacteria to become resistant, limiting future antibiotic options when you need them

- Dental problems can be caused by:
  - Tooth decay
  - Broken teeth
  - Gum disease
  - Jaw problems
  - Infections, not all of which require antibiotic therapy
