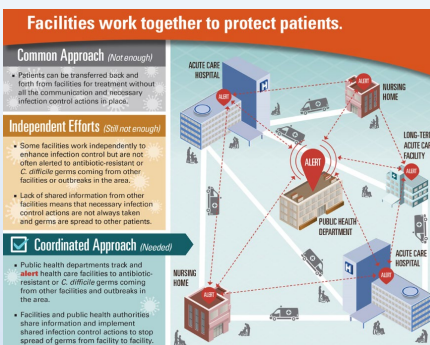


# Infection Control Assessment & Response (ICAR) Prevention Assessment

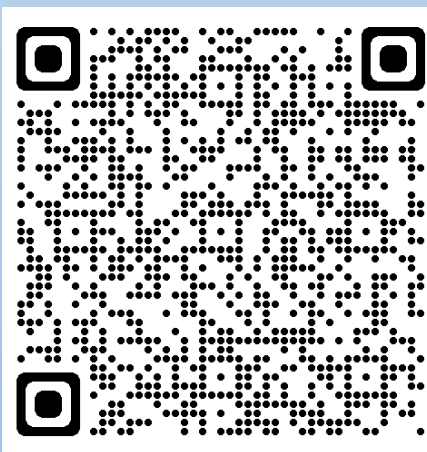
## Site-Specific Assessments
