

# Vector-borne Surveillance Report

CDC Week 32: Aug 9 - 15, 2026

## Highlights:

- **NJDOH is reporting one human case of West Nile Virus (WNV) in Monmouth County. To date, there has been one human case and two presumptive viremic donors (PVD).**
- **Since last week's report, 110 additional mosquito pools tested positive for WNV, for a total of 537 positive pools from 20 counties. Mosquito detections this year are higher than historical averages.**
- **The average number of Culex mosquitoes, which are associated with WNV transmission, was highest in Bergen and Hudson counties.**
- **One mosquito pool tested positive for Jamestown Canyon Virus (JCV) in week 32 from Union County. There have been no human cases of JCV in 2026.**
- **There have been no human or animal cases, or mosquito detections of Eastern equine encephalitis (EEE) in 2026.**
- **The number of Lyme disease cases continued to decrease this week and remains below historical averages.**
- **The number of tick-related emergency department visits continued to decrease and is level with historical averages.**

## Human Vector-borne Disease Cases

N.J.A.C. 8:57 mandates public health reporting of communicable diseases. 2026 data reflect cases that have been approved by NJDOH and do not include cases under investigation. Due to the time needed for public health investigation, the number of tickborne diseases (except for Lyme disease) may be significantly lower than actual counts and should be interpreted with caution. All 2026 numbers are preliminary and subject to change. Some cases are considered "presumptive positive" and are pending additional testing. Case counts for 2025 reflect the annual total for that year.

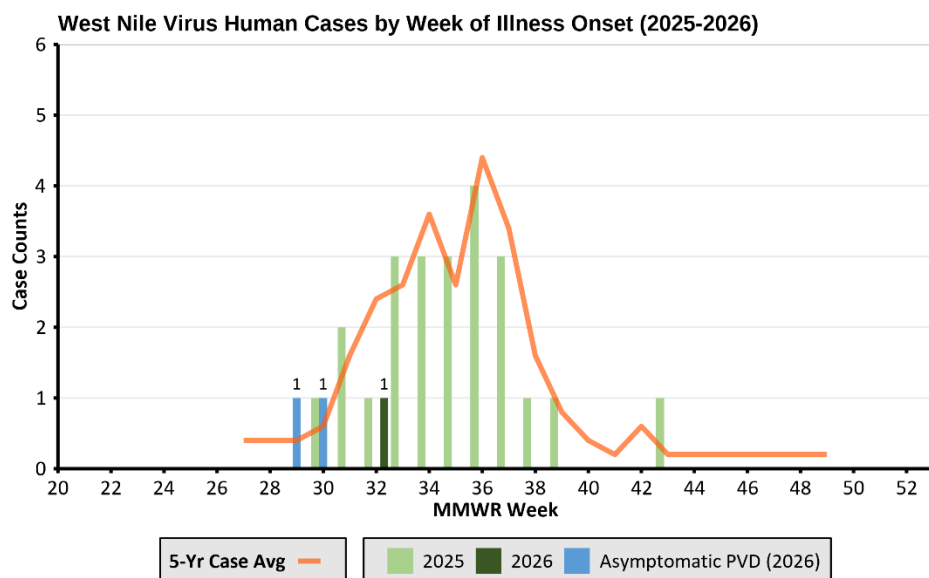
## Mosquito-borne Disease Activity

The New Jersey Department of Health Public Health and Environmental Laboratories (PHEL) and the Cape May County Department of Mosquito Control Bio-safety Level 3 Laboratory (CMBSL3) perform arboviral testing on mosquito pools collected by county mosquito control agencies throughout NJ.

*Test results may be incomplete as counties submit pools for testing on specific weekdays. Data reflects test results downloaded from JerseySurv on August 20, 2026 at 12:00 pm.*

## West Nile Virus

- One human case of WNV has been reported in 2026 from Monmouth County. Two PVDs were reported in Bergen and Camden counties.
- There have been no animal cases of WNV reported in 2026.
- State mosquito surveillance and testing started May 18<sup>th</sup>, although some counties collected "early season" samples (403 mosquito pools collected prior to week 20). All 21 counties have submitted mosquitoes for testing and out of 6,588 pools tested, 537 have tested positive for WNV in 20 counties.
- WNV has been detected in *Culex pipiens/restuans/salinarius* (446), *Cx. pipiens* (42), *Aedes albopictus* (20), *Ae. japonicus* (17), *Ae. vexans* (3), *Cx. restuans* (2), *Cx. salinarius* (2), *Ae. triseriatus* (1), *Anopheles punctipennis* (1), *Coquillettia perturbans* (1), *Cx. territans* (1), and *Psorophora ciliata* (1) mosquitoes.



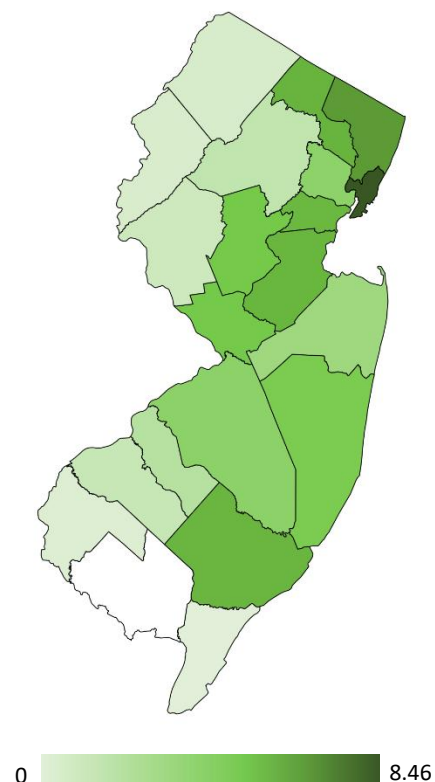

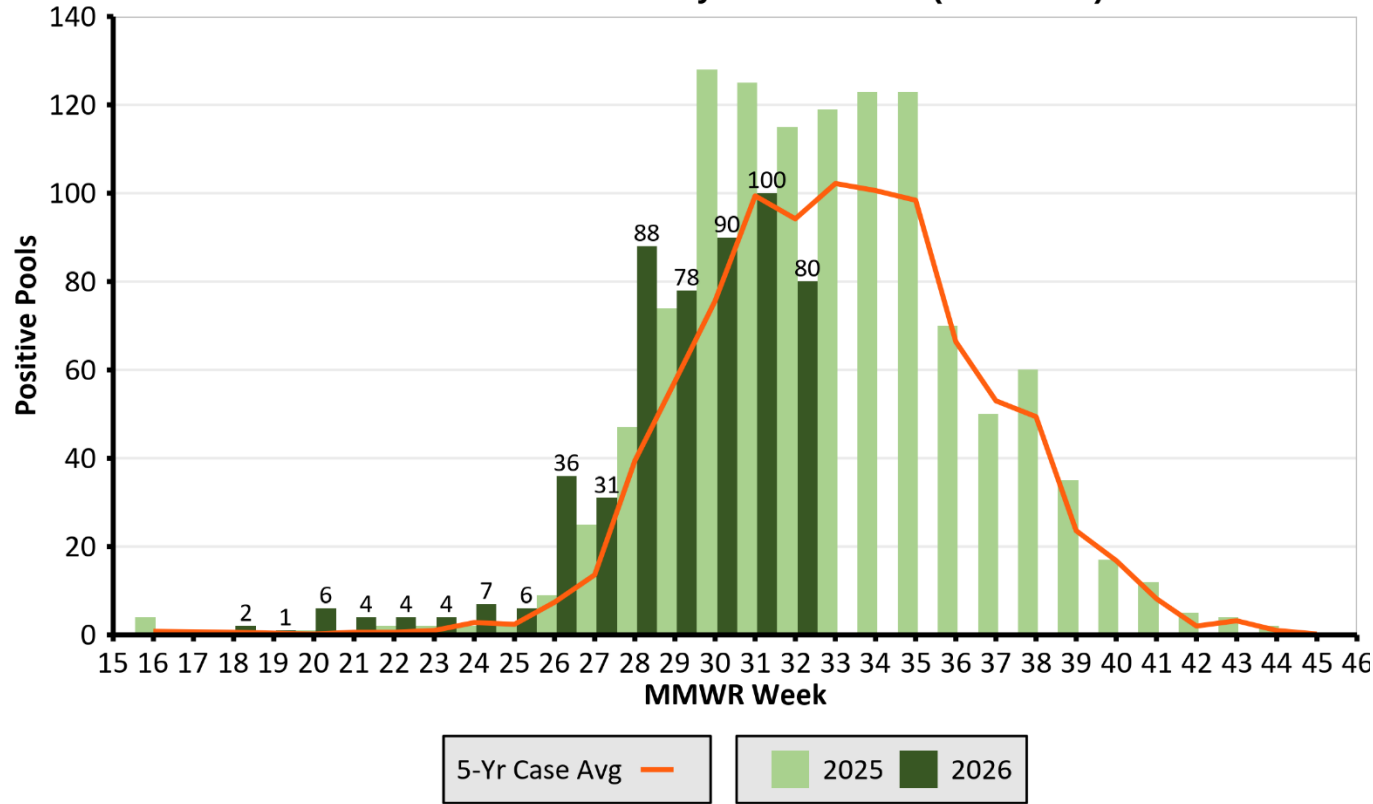

### Cumulative WNV MIR, 2026

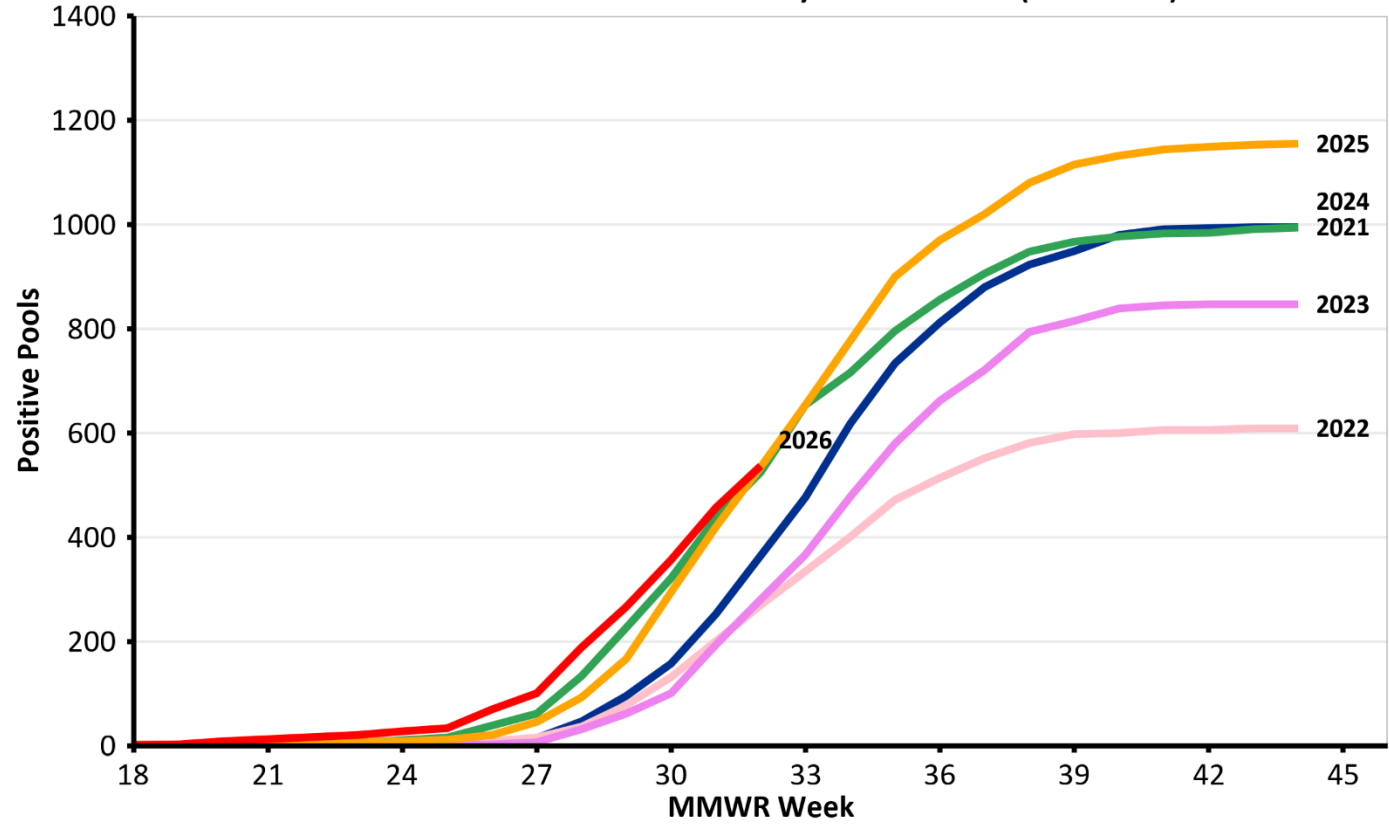

WNV Positive Pools by MMWR Week (2025-2026)

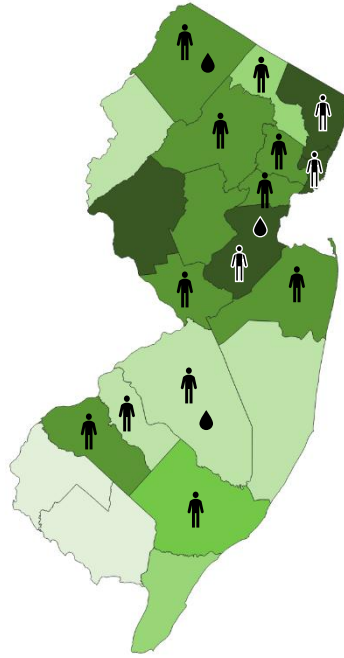
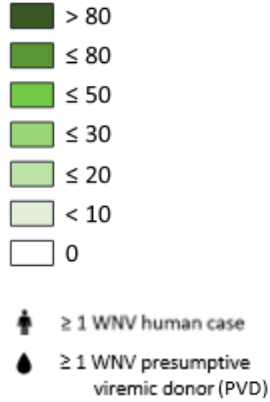


WNV Cumulative Positive Pools by MMWR Week (2021-2026)

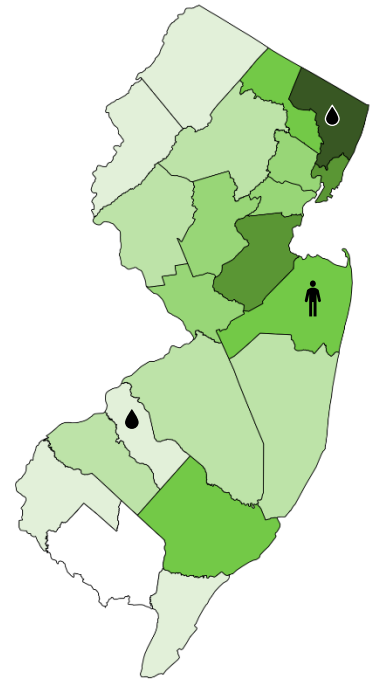

### WNV Positive Pools



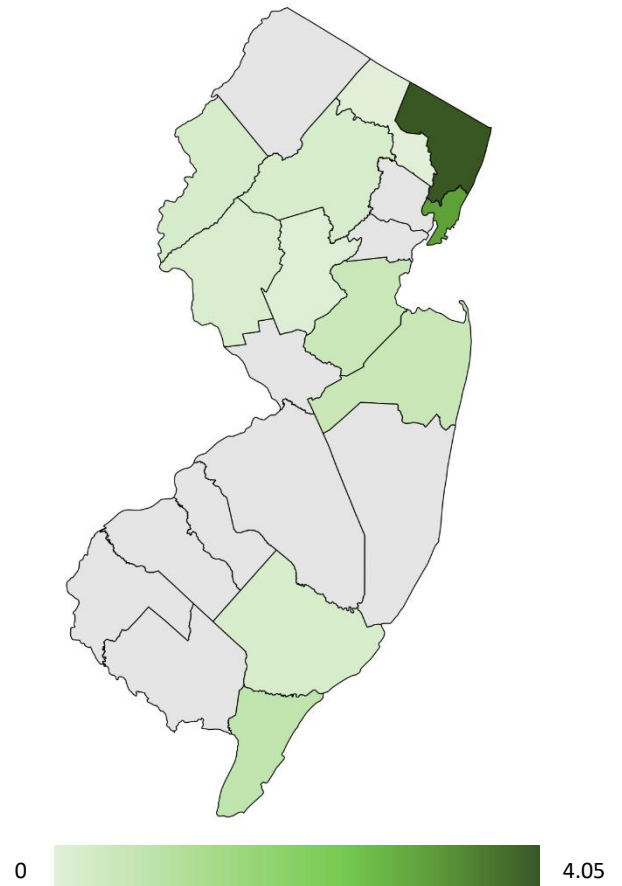

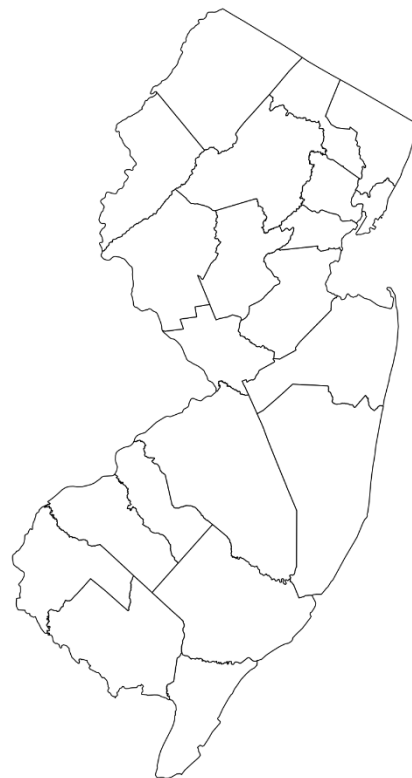
## Eastern Equine Encephalitis

- There have been no human or animal cases of EEE reported in 2026. EEE human cases were last reported in 2024 (2 cases).
- Out of 6,545 mosquito pools from 21 counties tested for EEE, none have tested positive.
- In 2025, the first EEE positive pool was detected in week 33 in Atlantic County.

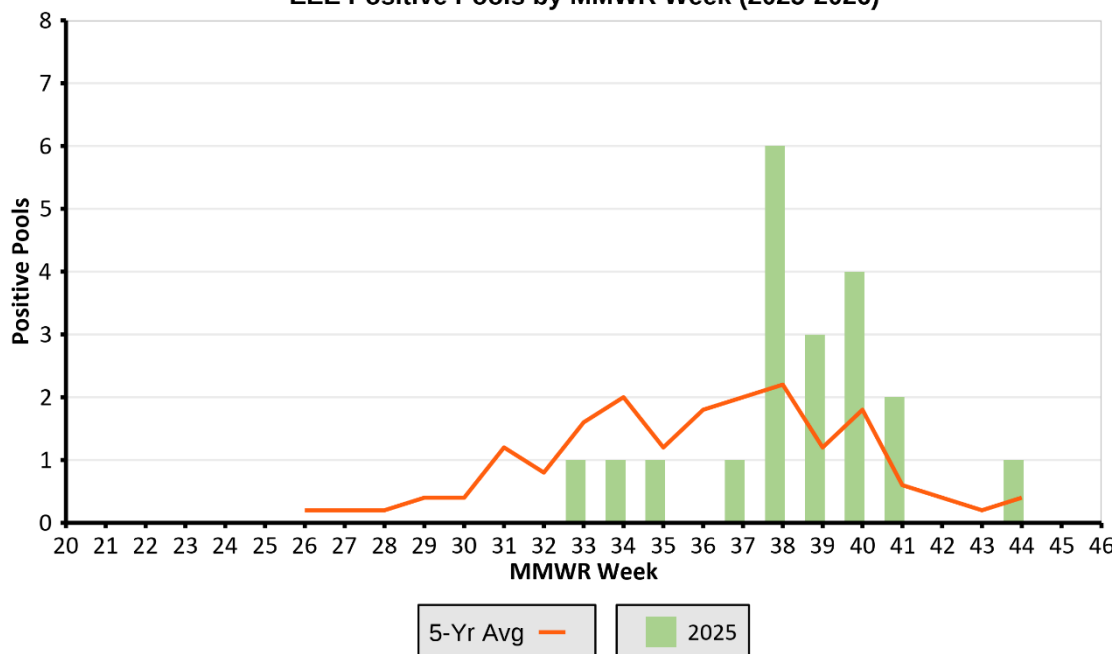

### Cumulative EEE MIR, 2026



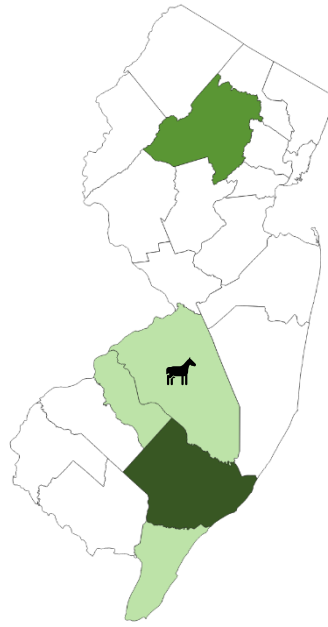
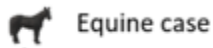

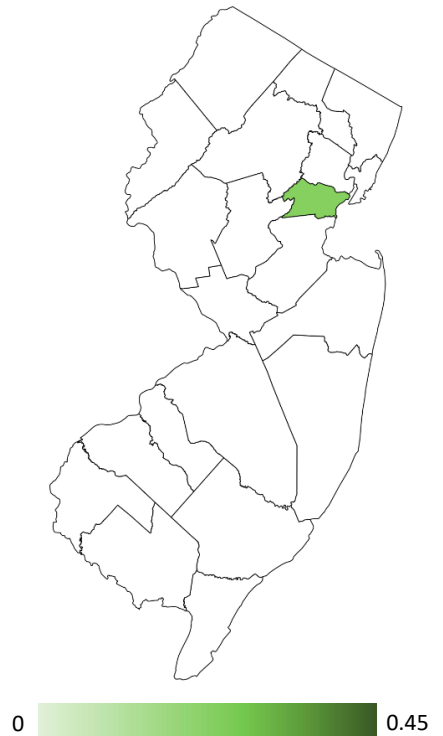
## Jamestown Canyon Virus

- There have been no human cases of JCV reported in NJ in 2026. In 2025, there were two human cases of JCV from Middlesex and Burlington counties.
- Out of 6,545 mosquito pools from 21 counties tested for JCV, one pool was positive from week 32 in Union County.
- In 2025, the first JCV positive pool was detected in week 29 in Sussex County.

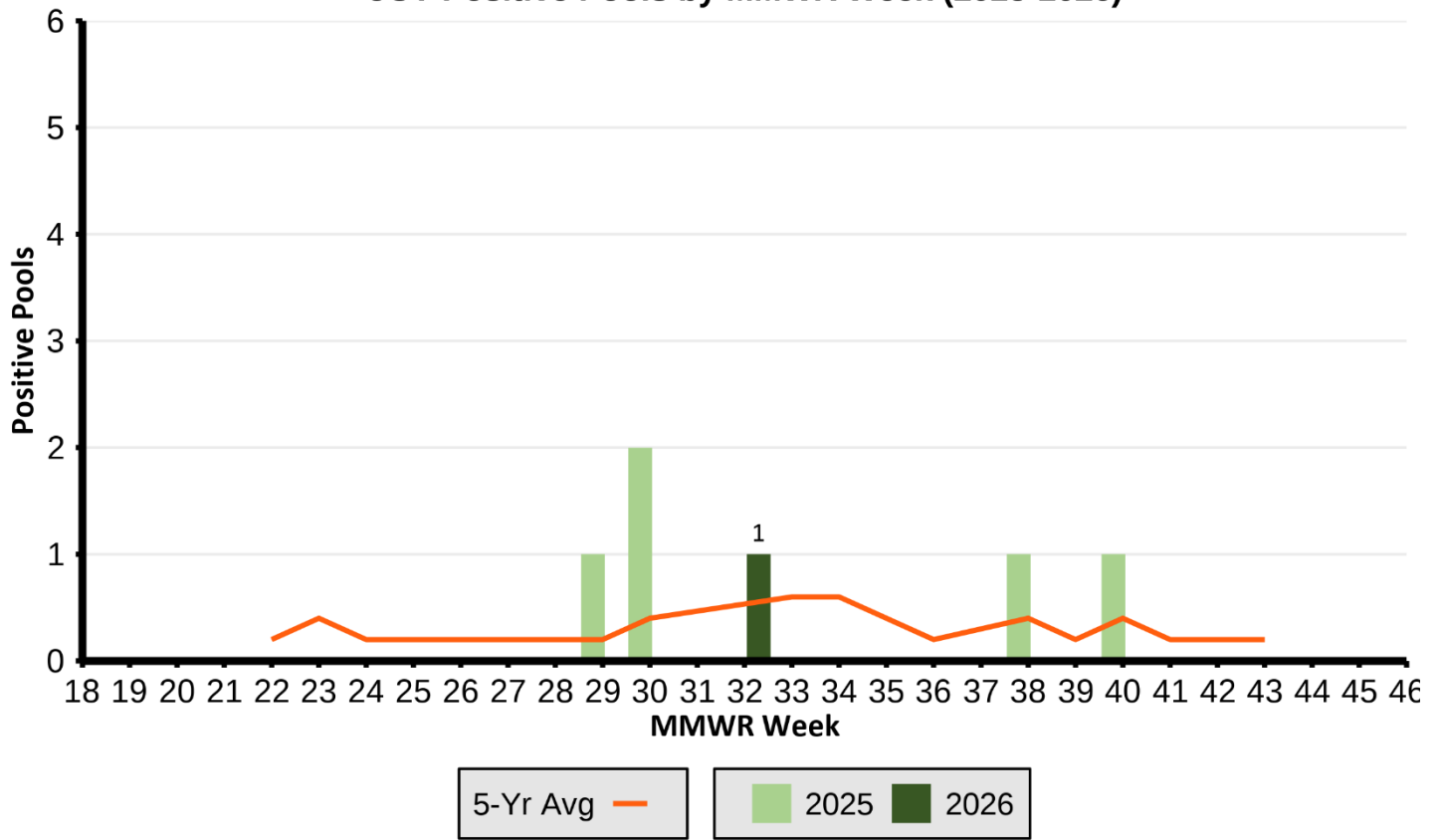
### Cumulative JCV MIR, 2026



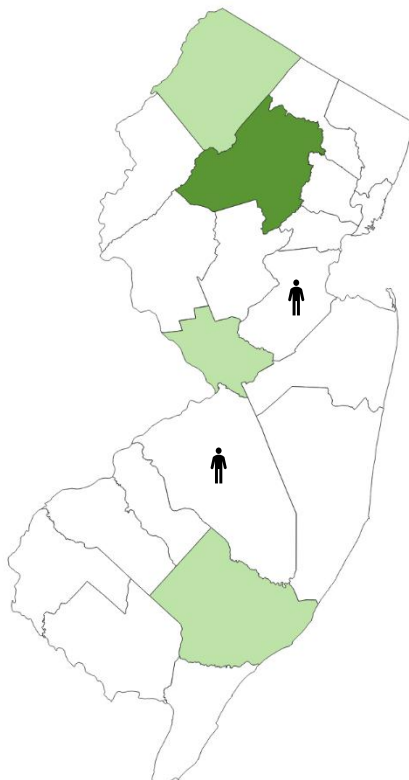

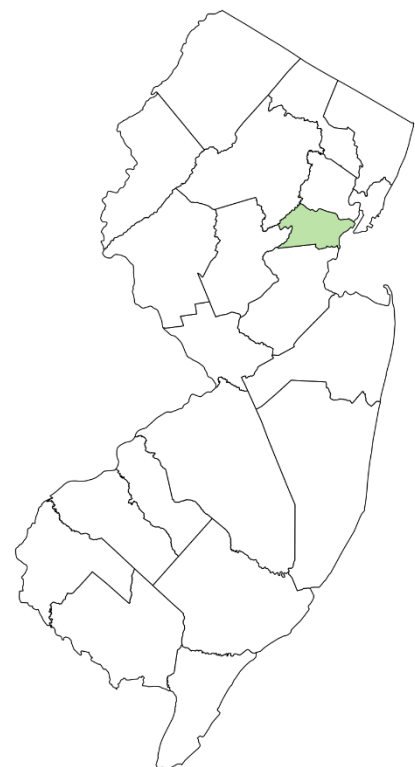
## JCV Positive Pools by MMWR Week (2025-2026)

## Other Mosquito-borne Diseases

- Mosquito pools in 21 counties have been tested for St. Louis encephalitis with no positive results.
- Mosquito pools in 9 counties have been tested for La Crosse encephalitis with no positive results.
- Mosquito pools in 5 counties have been tested for Chikungunya, Dengue, and Zika viruses with no positive results.

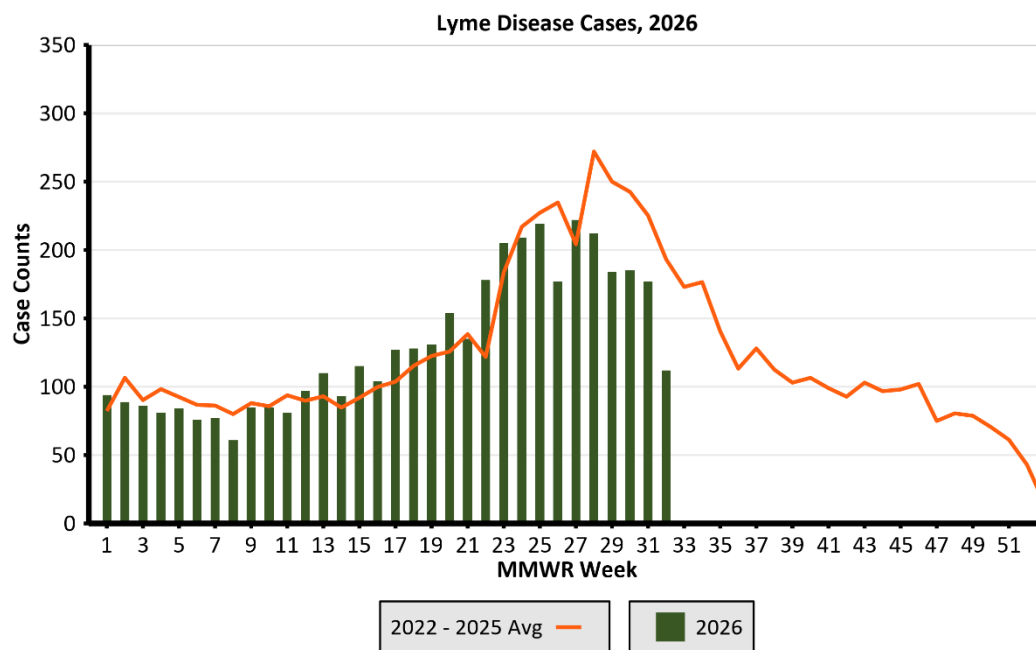

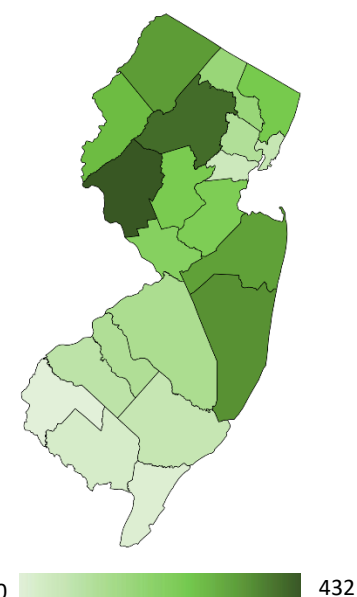
### Lyme Disease

- There have been 4,201 cases of Lyme disease reported in NJ in 2026.
- The number of cases in week 32 continues to decline and remains below the four-year average.
- The largest number of Lyme disease cases has been reported in the northwestern part of the state (Hunterdon, and Morris counties) as well as in Ocean County.



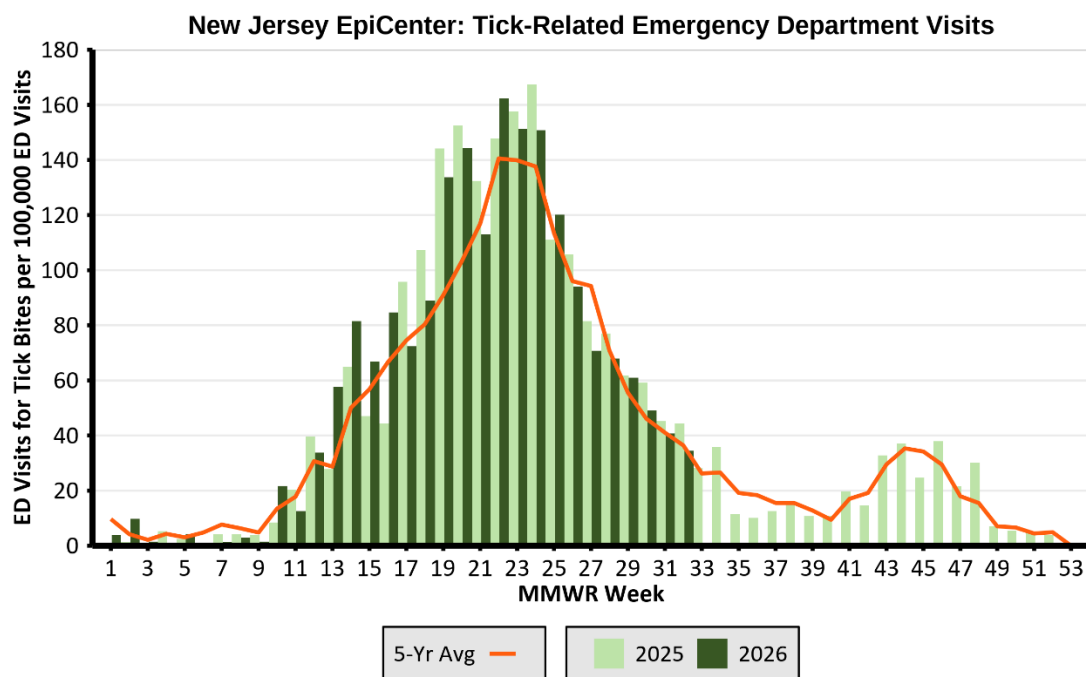


**Lyme Disease Cases, 2026**



### Tick-related Emergency Department Visits

The chart below represents NJ residents seen at emergency departments with a tick-bite complaint or signs/symptoms associated with a reported tick bite relative to total ED visits. The number of tick-related emergency department visits continued to decline and is at the 5-year average.
