

Getting the Routine 2024-2025 COVID-19 Vaccine

Everyone six months of age and older is recommended to get **at least one dose** of the 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine.*

- **Children 6 months to 11 years** can get Pfizer or Moderna.
- **People 12 years and older** can get Pfizer, Moderna, or Novavax.



CDC RECOMMENDATIONS BY AGE:



6 MONTHS – 4 YEARS

- Get at least one dose.
- The total number of doses depends on the number and type of COVID-19 vaccines you received in the past.**



5 – 11 YEARS

- Get one dose.



12 – 64 YEARS

- Get one dose.
- If you get Novavax and have not had a COVID-19 vaccine in the past, you are recommended to receive two doses.



65 YEARS & OLDER

- Get two doses with the second dose six months later.
- If you get Novavax and have not had a COVID-19 vaccine in the past, you are recommended to receive two doses followed by a third dose after six months.
