People with Weakened Immune Systems & COVID-19 Vaccine





If you have a weakened immune system, you are more likely to get severely ill from COVID-19. People with weakened immune systems are recommended to receive an additional dose^{*} of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna), and a booster dose^{**}:

- An additional shot of an mRNA vaccine is recommended 28 days after completing your primary series [(starting dose(s)], since
- you may not have received enough protection from these beginning dose(s).
- •
- • A booster dose is recommended after the additional dose. Protection from vaccines can decrease over time, but this
- booster dose helps to bring that protection back!

This includes people who have:





Moderate or severe **primary immunodeficiency** (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)



Received an **organ transplant** and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system





Received a **stem cell transplant** within past 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

*People with weakened immune systems are recommended to receive an additional dose of an mRNA (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) vaccine plus a booster dose. The additional dose is recommended 28 days after completing the primary series [(starting dose(s)].

**The timing between the additional dose and the booster depends on the vaccine you received for your primary series:

If you received Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) two-dose primary series: Booster dose is recommended at least 3 months after the additional dose for a total of four doses.

If you received a Johnson & Johnson (J&J)/Janssen one-dose primary series: Booster dose is recommended at least 2 months after the additional dose for at total of three doses.

Everyone ages 12 and older is recommended to receive a booster dose. For those 18 and older, any of the COVID-19 vaccines can be used for the booster dose, but Pfizer or Moderna is preferred. You may get Johnson & Johnson's Janssen COVID-19 vaccine in some situations.
