**Certificate of Waiver for  
Basic Life Support Services  
Pursuant to the Provisions of the New Jersey Administrative Code  
Specifically, N.J.A.C. 8:40-1.4, a waiver is issued to:**

ALL BLS Licensed Providers

Granting relief from the following provision(s) of Chapter 8:40 of the New Jersey Administrative Code in response to the public health emergency declared in New Jersey in response to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak:


**N.J.A.C. 8:40-2.4 Exemptions from licensing requirements**

- (a) **Any person, public or private institution, agency, entity, corporation or business concern providing mobility assistance or basic life support care in any form or manner, where the transport originates within the State of New Jersey, shall first be licensed by the Department in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. For the purpose of this paragraph, geographic areas of exclusive Federal jurisdiction shall not be considered "within the State of New Jersey."**

This waiver is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Out-of-State BLS providers, who are not currently licensed by the Department of Health but are validly licensed or otherwise authorized to operate in their home state, may operate in New Jersey if they meet all other requirements as set forth under N.J.A.C. 8:40 et. seq., have not had a BLS license revoked by the Department of Health and do not have a license currently under summary suspension by the Department of Health.
