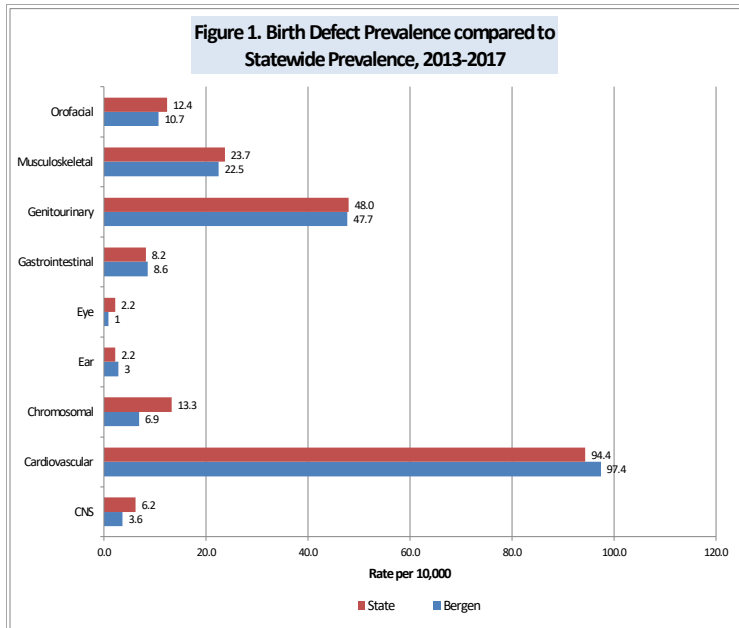
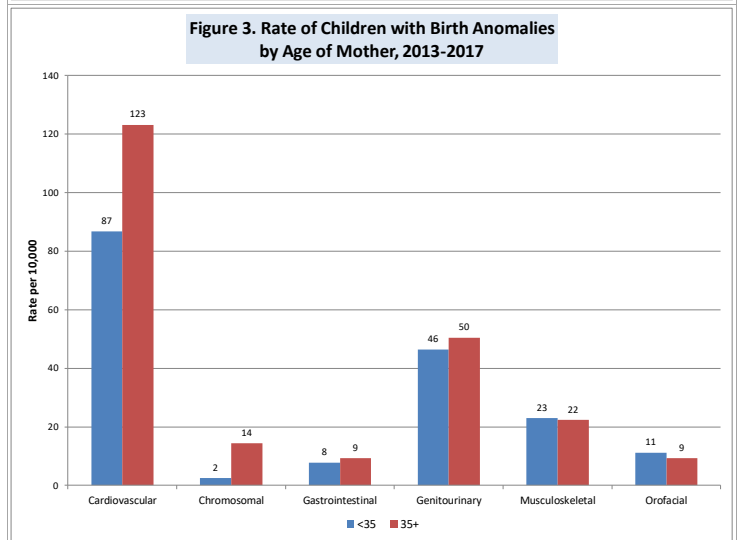
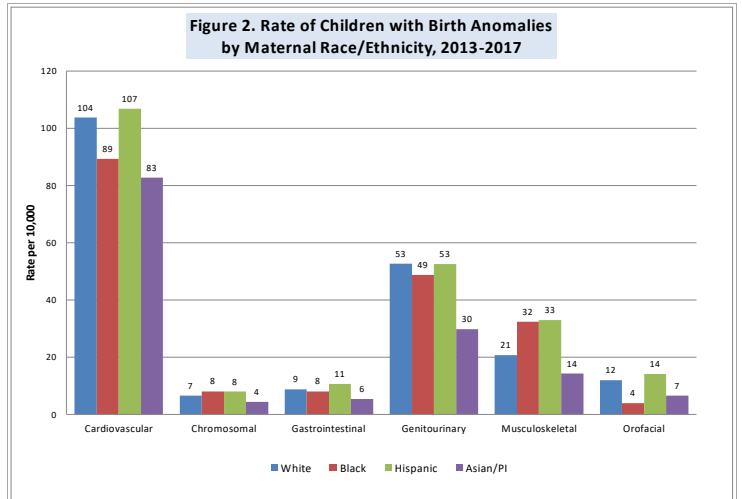

Figure 2: White and Hispanic children have the highest rate of genitourinary conditions; Black and Hispanic children have the highest rate of musculoskeletal conditions.

Figure 3: Older mothers (35+) are more likely to have children with chromosomal and cardiovascular abnormalities.
