





Figure 1: Mercer county has more cardiovascular, chromosomal and fewer genitourinary birth defects compared to state average.

Figure 2: Black children have the highest rate of cardiovascular conditions; Hispanic children have the highest rate of chromosomal conditions.

Figure 3: Older mothers (35+) are more likely to have children with chromosomal abnormality.
