**SUBJECT:** Continued Temporary Extra CVBs for WIC Participants in FFY 2023  
As of October 1, 2022– until further notice

The Continuing Resolution provides additional funds to the New Jersey WIC Program to temporarily offer women and children additional WIC benefits for the purchase of fruits and vegetables. The WIC Program is able to continue to provide extra CVB benefits for WIC Participants until further notice.

The increased fruit and vegetable amounts for eWIC cardholders are referred to as Cash Value Benefit (CVB) and included on the eWIC cardholders benefit balance. Eligible WIC participants will receive additional CVB benefits ranging from \$25 to \$73.50 per month.
