: Notice of Voluntary Surrender  
: Nurse Aide Certificate

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, under authority of federal law, imposes a requirement on state governments (42CFR Part 483, et al.) to ensure that nurse aides have the education and clinical skills necessary to care for residents of long term care facilities. These regulations also require that each State maintain a nurse aide Registry, which pursuant to 42CFR 483.156(c)(1)(iv), must contain all substantiated findings by the State of resident abuse, resident neglect or misappropriation of resident property by a certified nurse aide.

On March 20, 2018, you waived your right to a hearing and agreed to a voluntary surrender of your nurse aide certification, NA 8660488. The consequences of waiving your right to a hearing are the same as if the allegations against you were substantiated at a hearing. You surrendered your nurse aide certificate and indicated you were unable to locate your wallet card. Your nurse aide certification and your nurse aide wallet card are invalid, and a finding of abuse has been placed next to your name in the Registry and this shall remain revoked permanently, effective March 27, 2018.
