ORDER LIFTING CURTAILMENT

OF ADMISSIONS AND DIRECTED PLAN OF

This letter confirms the verbal order given to George Mervine, Administrator Consultant, and Yisroel Miller, Administrator, on August 28, 2023, lifting the curtailment of admissions, including readmissions, and the Directed Plan of Correction (DPOC). On July 18, 2023, the Department of Health (hereinafter, "the Department") issued a written order curtailing all admissions to Majestic Center for Rehab and Subacute Care (hereinafter "Majestic Center"), including readmissions, and ordering a DPOC requiring Majestic Center to hire a New Jersey Licensed Nursing Home administrator, to retain the fulltime services of a Consultant Administrator and Consultant Director of Nursing, and to take temperature readings of every room in the facility each shift and to send temperature logs to the Department. The DPOC also required the facility to have the Medical Director or a physician designee reassess all residents of the facility.

On July 21, 2023, the Department sent Majestic Center an amended order which required the facility to comply with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-14.4, which provides that nursing homes shall be equipped with air conditioning in all areas used by residents that maintains the temperature in these areas at a temperature not in excess of 81 degrees Fahrenheit. The amended order also required the facility to train its supervisory staff on the requirements of the facility's comprehensive emergency operations plan and heat emergency action plan, and to train all staff on measures for addressing heat and other emergencies.

By virtue of this written order, the Department lifts the curtailment of admissions issued to Majestic Center, effective as of August 28, 2023. The Department also lifts the DPOC requiring Majestic Center to retain the services of a Consultant Administrator and Consultant Director of Nursing, the Medical Director or physician designee to reassess all residents, and for the facility to send temperature logs to the Department. In addition, the Department lifts the DPOC requirements set forth in the amended order including the training requirements on emergency operations. However, Majestic Center is still expected to comply with the requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 26:2H-14.4 as it pertains to maintaining acceptable temperatures throughout the facility.
