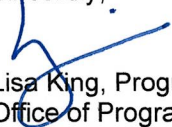
On August 12, 2026, the New Jersey Department of Health (the Department) issued to The Fountains of Atco (the facility) (both the long-term care and assisted living facility) an order curtailing new admissions and readmissions to the facility and a Directed Plan of Correction that was needed to ensure the health and safety of the residents in its care due to the identification of water management concerns at the facility involving the *Legionella* pathogen.

The original Directed Plan of Correction required the facility to separately retain the full-time, on-site services of an Administrator Consultant and a Certified Infection Control Practitioner (ICP) Consultant. Effective immediately, the Department is amending Section A of the Directed Plan of Correction to allow the facility to jointly retain the full-time, on-site services of one joint Administrator Consultant and one joint ICP. The Department expects the facility to maintain the previously approved consultant firm, which has both Licensed Nursing Home Administrator and Certified Assisted Living Administrator credentials, to provide ongoing support and expertise to both the long-term care facility and the assisted living facility. The Department also expects the ICP to provide appropriate and ongoing oversight of both the assisted living and long-term care facilities. The Administrator Consultant's and ICP Consultant's responsibilities and attention should be appropriately balanced between both settings to ensure that infection prevention and control practices are consistently implemented and monitored with respect to each separately licensed provider. All other terms of the Directed Plan of Correction remain in effect. If the previously approved consultant firm ceases to provide services to the facility, the facility shall promptly notify the Department, and the Department may reconsider at that time whether separate consultants for the two facilities should be reinstated.
