HEALTH EQUITY COMMUNITY CONVERSATIONS

- Amanda presented a summary of recent discussions between the NJDOH Office of Minority and Multicultural Health (<u>OMMH</u>), the NJDOH <u>Population Health Summit</u> planning team, and the HNJAC and HNJCC chairs. This year, OMMH's annual health equity forums will instead be "community conversations" with various priority populations to discuss how the HNJ2030 Focus Issues affect them and solicit ideas for improvement.
- 2. Already suggested priority populations were presented and ideas for others were solicited:
 - Economic status
 - Disproportionate exposure to environmental pollutants
 - Mental health
 - Victims of violent crimes
 - HIV-position individuals

- 3. Asking that HNJAC members act as co-facilitators of the Health Equity Community Conversations. Training will be provided to those who need/want it.
