What we're doing:


1. Review each action plan

# GOALS OF THE HN2030 SENIOR STAFF

## Senior Staff Action Plan Reviewing Guidelines:

1. Action plan teams are volunteers from the private sector, academia, non-profits and state and local government who are experts in their respective fields
2. Action plan recommendations should align with ongoing/upcoming DOH initiatives
3. Raise any concerns about feasibility, including resource allocation
4. Plans may not cover every aspect of a particular topic area or DOH agenda, but reviewers should note critical gaps
5. Each team has considered potential overlaps with other state agency plans, e.g., Nurture NJ and DOT's Strategic Highway Safety Plan; in some instances, redundancy serves as emphasis on particular public health goals
