INTRODUCTION

Thirty-one community based agencies provide HIV health education risk reduction (HERR) services at 41 locations in New Jersey. Funding for programs comes from the Division of HIV, STD, and TB Services (DHSTS) of both the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH), and the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The HIV prevention services provided include varying forms individual- and/or group-level HIV HERR interventions that assist individuals to reduce their risk for HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. Target populations include people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA), injecting drug users (IDU), at-risk women, men who have sex with men (MSM), and the sexual and syringe-sharing partners of these individuals. All projects are located in urban, suburban, rural areas heavily impacted by the HIV epidemic, including 17 cities and the New Jersey counties heavily impacted by HIV infection.
