Notice of Cancellation of Certificate of Need Call for Home Health Care Services

Take notice that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 8:33, Judith M. Persichilli, R.N., B.S.N., M.A., Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Health (Department), hereby publishes notice that the certificate of need (CN) call for applications for home health care services in accordance with the provisions at N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 8:33-4.1(a)2, originally scheduled for July 1, 2022, is hereby cancelled. The Department has determined that additional home health care services are not needed at this time.

The Department published a notice of postponement of the July 1, 2022 home health care services CN call on June 6, 2022, at 54 N.J.R. 1105(a). Since that time, the Department was able to gather and evaluate data and determined there was no need for additional home health care services. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:33-4.1(a), the next scheduled call for home health care services will be July 1, 2025. However, if in the interim a need for additional home health care services is documented, the Commissioner may issue a call prior to July 1, 2025.
