Notice of Postponement of Certificate of Need Call for New General Long-Term Care Beds and Services

Take notice that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq., Jeffrey A. Brown, Acting Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Health (Department), hereby publishes notice that the July 1, 2025, call for certificate of need (CN) applications for general long-term care beds and services, in accordance with the provisions at N.J.A.C. 8:39 and N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq., is hereby postponed.

Currently, the Department is preparing a survey to determine whether there is a need for a CN call for new general long-term care beds and services. As such, the Department is postponing the CN call for new general long-term care beds and services to further assess current needs.

If the Department proceeds with a CN call, a notice for submission of CN applications for new general long-term care beds and services will be published in a future issue of the New Jersey Register, which will provide the necessary time for both potential applicants and interested parties to respond to the future CN call notice. In the alternative, if the determination is made to cancel the CN call, then the Department will publish a cancellation notice in a future issue of the New Jersey Register.
