1	PDF Documents	<p>When trying to open a Portable Document Format (PDF), I am receiving an error message and am unable to access the PDF. How should I proceed?</p> <p>It is recommended that users utilize Microsoft Edge to view PDFs. Certain PDF forms cannot be opened in the Chrome or Firefox built in PDF viewers that are enabled by default. If using Chrome or Firefox it is recommended that the file is downloaded instead by clicking the download button in the upper right-hand corner of the browser after an error message is received. An alternative option is to disable the built in PDF viewers in Chrome or Firefox.</p>
2	Quote Submission	<p>Should I check that I have properly completed and attached all of the required documents with my submitted Quote?</p> <p>Yes. Prior to the Quote Opening Deadline, a Bidder should review the documents comprising the submitted Quote to ensure that all of the required documents have been completed and attached. Oftentimes a Quote is deemed non-responsive because a Bidder fails to attach a required form or attaches a blank form.</p>

3	Quote Submission	<p>Please confirm a Bidder may deliver a hardcopy quote instead of submitting a response electronically.</p> <p>Please be advised that all Quotes shall be submitted electronically via email to centralprocurement@doh.nj.gov.</p>
4	Section 3.1 Quote Submission	<p>We have completed several bids before with different state and government entities, but this is our first one with New Jersey in some time. As a result, I was curious if our original quote sent over has been applied to this bid, or if we need to fill out the attached forms to place our bid.</p> <p>This procurement is considered a new bidding opportunity. Any forms, certifications, technical Quotes, pricing, etc., that may have been submitted for any other procurement, even if seemingly similar, are not considered part of a Quote submission for this bidding opportunity. The Bidder is advised that if it intends to reuse any previously submitted Quote documentation, it carefully review and/or update its documentation to match the exact requirements of this procurement, as it may not resemble the identical requirements of any prior procurement.</p> <p>Request for Quotes Section 3 <i>Quote Submission Requirements</i> outlines all of the Quote submission requirements and the timing of those requirements. Please carefully consider whether the language indicates “shall” or “should” or other determinate language.</p> <p>Certain forms are exempt from submission provided the Bidder’s NJSTART profile indicates such on a case-by-case basis pursuant to Request for Quotes Sections 3.10.1 <i>Offer and Acceptance Page</i> through 3.10.14 <i>Certification Of Non-Involment In Prohibited Activities In Russia or Belarus Pursuant To P.L.2022, C3</i>.</p>
5	Section 3.1 Quote Submission	<p>We have not heard back from your team yet. Have you already previously received quote #251002-8085Rev1 from us? If so, is this enough to complete the bid on your end? If not, do we need to share the quote or complete the previously attached forms to finish this bid?</p> <p>Please refer to Question #4.</p>

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to be knowledgeable of all of the additions, deletions, clarifications, and modifications to the Bid Solicitation/RFQ, as set forth in all Bid Amendments.
