

## I. Major research and public service activities

The University actively pursues outside resources for its activities. In FY 2007, \$3,475,008 grant dollars were received through the University's Office of Sponsored Programs. Many of these grants were for student-related activities and professional development activities in addition to faculty research. This figure also includes grants from the State of New Jersey and private foundations. For example, the Geraldine R. Dodge Foundation helped fund the Summer Jazz program and the New Jersey Council on the Arts generously supports the University's long- running Jazz Room Series. The University's Alumni Relations office also awarded nearly \$40,000 in grants to faculty and other William Paterson offices. The figures below are a subset of the \$3,475,008. They represent only federal funds and only funds for faculty research and public service activities.
