Trump Signs Several Executive Orders regarding Higher Education

On April 23, 2025, several executive orders were signed that carry potential implications for NJ higher education:

- <u>Transparency Regarding Foreign Influence at American Universities</u>
- <u>Reforming Accreditation to Strengthen Higher Education</u>
- <u>Preparing Americans for High-Paying Skilled Trade Jobs of the Future</u>
- <u>Restoring Equality of Opportunity and Meritocracy</u>
- Advancing Artificial Intelligence Education for American Youth

The State, along with OSHE, will continue to monitor the implications of the federal action on higher education in New Jersey. Institutions should continue to monitor for updates and guidance as the situation evolves.

Updates on Litigation
