Subject: Air Traffic Control Training Programs Survey

The Federal Aviation Administration and the National Air Traffic Controllers' Association have identified that over ninety percent (90%) of the nation's airport terminal towers are understaffed. This shortage has only worsened due to the federal government shutdown that began on October 1, 2025. We aim to address this challenge, starting with initiatives in New Jersey.

On June 19, 2025 the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) <u>issued a broadcast</u> encouraging eligible institutions to apply for the Air Traffic-Collegiate Training Initiative. We are now seeking insights into current aviation programs as well as the potential for developing new pathways in air traffic control and aviation programs.
