Subject: Opportunity for Institutions to Sign Up for 2025 State Opportunity Index Survey

The <u>State Opportunity Index</u> was developed by Strada, to help states develop stronger, more equitable pathways to opportunity with a focus on five priority areas: Affordability, Employer Alignment, Quality Coaching, Work-Based Learning, and Clear Outcomes. In preparation for the next report and to obtain a more robust national sample, they invite **public institutions of higher education** to sign up to distribute a student survey to help assess quality coaching and work-based learning.

It is free to participate and in return, public institutions that participate will: receive reports on the education-to-career guidance and work-based learning experiences of their students, a customized summary report with comparisons to peer and national benchmarks, and a deidentified data file to assist in evaluation and program improvement efforts.

Interested institutions must sign up and complete an agreement before March 2025. From February to April, students will participate in the survey data collection. In June institutions would receive de-identified results from their campus and in October 2025, institutions would receive reports.

About The State Opportunity Index

With increased focus on ensuring that individuals experience the full-promise of a college education, educators, employers, and policy makers seek research-based insights to inform solutions for all parties—especially students. In 2024, the inaugural State Opportunity Index included national survey results about students' experiences with two opportunities linked to better post-graduation outcomes: quality education-to-career guidance and work-based learning. The research shows that student experiences vary significantly by their field of study, race/ethnicity, gender, and first generation status.

In order to help public universities and colleges identify their strengths and opportunities to improve students' academic and career outcomes, the 2025 State Opportunity Index Survey is being made available free of charge to interested institutions. Participating institutions will receive the results and data set from their own students with aggregate benchmarks for self-comparisons. Each institutions anonymized data will be aggregated to calculate national, state, and peer benchmarks for public reporting.

The spring 2025 survey cohort will target seniors at four-year institutions and all community college students, excluding those in dual enrollment programs, from a select group of institutions. This implementation will also feature a nationally representative benchmark sample. The results of the survey will provide institutional leaders with a comparison of their data to peer and national benchmarks as a tool to inform improvements to quality education-to-career guidance and work-based learning experiences.
