Subject: Student Success Virtual Discussion / Listening Session

In 2023, a team led by the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE), alongside the New Jersey Council of County Colleges (NJCCC) and the Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA), was one of five state teams selected to participate in the SHEEO|CUNY Accelerated Study in Associate Programs (ASAP) Learning Community.

As part of this Learning Community, the New Jersey state team seeks input from our 18 county colleges related to student success program models and initiatives you are currently engaged with.

We invite each county college to send 2-3 staff to a virtual discussion / listening session on Thursday, August 1st from 9:30am - 11:00am. Our goals for this session are 1) to gain a deeper understanding of your ongoing student success efforts and 2) to share some highlights from the Learning Community about essential elements of the ASAP model. Colleges do not need to prepare formal presentations. The format will include OSHE and NJCCC moderators posing questions to the group, including what student success practices you find most impactful for which groups of students, where student success programs are located at your institution, and what recommendations you would make to strengthen student success.
